Dear Parents and/or Guardians...

This month we are learning about curiosity. Curious people usually inquire about information they do not need to know but are simply seeking answers to questions in order to gain more and better knowledge for themselves. Curiosity is a key component for children to learn. It helps them gain knowledge but also helps them make connections between different pieces of information. It is important for parents to create an environment for curious children by allowing questions and learning to occur.

HOW CAN YOU HELP?

- Encourage your children to ask questions. Do not brush off children who ask too many questions because sometimes they are simply seeking more knowledge.
- Find books, magazines, tv shows or games that help stimulate your children to ask questions. You can play games as a family or share books and magazines and then have a weekly discussion about them.
- Visit the library. When your children have questions, take a visit to the library. Sit and read books or check books out on topics that they are curious about. This gives them credible sources of gaining quality information.
- Reward your children for being curious and learning new things. This drive for more information can be initiated by the outcome of a reward
- Encourage your children to participate in experiments. Whether they be at school or in the home, participating in experiments leads children to be curious and ask more questions about what they are doing.
